## Primary Summer Camp

(Robyn and Audrey)

Ages 3-6

Full Day 8:30 - 4:00

Half Day 8:30 - 12:00

Each week will have a special theme. On Fridays there will be a special visitor or activity to end the week. The weekly themes and related activities are specifically designed to meet the developmental needs of 3-6 year old children.

***If your child is enrolling as a new student in the Primary Classroom for the 2017-2018 school year, the summer program offers an excellent opportunity for the child and the parents to become acquainted with our school environment.***

Week 1

**Weaving It All Together** - This week we will learn various ways to weave. We will learn and practice and create on various looms with an assortment of materials.

Week 2

**All About Art** - Spend the week creating! Your child will create masterpieces using many different materials and mediums. The week will be filled with the wonders of color and texture. From pinch pots to fairy putty and so much in between.

Week 3

**Down By the Sea** - Let's learn about the animals and plant life that thrive on our New England coastline. We will use gifts from the sea to create wonderful art projects.

Week 4

**Puppet Productions** - Your kids will learn about different styles of puppetry. We will have fun learning to create different types of puppets and perform on a puppet style theater with popcorn and all! "The Puppet Lady," Cheryl Incandella, will spend Friday morning working with and sharing with the kids!

**Game On!** - Outside games and inside games. This week is all about learning new games and new skills. Get your game on! So many games, so little time!

## Elementary Summer Camp

(Willa)

Ages 6-12

Full Day 8:30 - 4:00

Half Day 8:30 - 12:00

Each week campers will dive deeply into gaining knowledge and skills around the given theme. The mornings will focus on activities and projects with the help and support of special guests and the teachers. In the afternoons there will be opportunities for your child to work with the Montessori materials in the classroom. All of the themes and the activities will be designed to meet the developmental needs of 6-12 year old children.

Week 1

**Beyond the Page: The Art of Book Making** - Explore the art of book making and discover that there is more to a book than meets the eye. These works of art can be sketch books, journals, graphic novels or even gifts! We will create a variety of book forms and experiment with different paper techniques.

Week 2

**Around the World in 5 Days** - Your child will embark on a journey around the world! This week will be a perfect combination of study and play. Your child will have so much fun learning about the different cultures and the histories through the sports, games, music and art of each country.

Week 3

**Camp Rock- A Beatles Celebration** - Derek Waldron will take your child on a weeklong musical adventure. The Beatles had an undeniable influence on music. Their impact is still felt in today's music. This wonderful week of exploring your voice and different instruments will showcase the influence the Beatles have on our current culture. The week will end in an incredible performance!

Week 4

**The Dog Days of Summer** - Spend the week learning about dogs and how we care for them, how important they are to families, and how we rescue them. Karla from Home Sweet Home Pet Resort will bring a couple of dogs each day and share her knowledge. This will be an exciting week of activities based around our love for animals!

## Upper Elementary Summer Camp

(Hannah)

Ages 9-12

Full Day 8:30 - 4:00

Half Day 8:30 - 12:00

Each morning will be very specific to the theme of the week. The group will submerge into that theme, learning new skills and producing both group projects, as well as individual take home projects. The afternoon will allow opportunities for group games and activities both inside and outside-weather dependant. One afternoon each week will be an off school adventure or hike. All themes and activities will be designed to meet the developmental needs of 9-12 year old children.

Week 1

**Fired Up!** - Spend a week getting muddy! Come and explore the magical medium of clay. This week will be spent creating treasures big and small, using our imaginations and a variety of pottery techniques such as pinching, slab building and coiling. The week will culminate in creating a clay mask.

Week 2

**Let's Get Cookin'** - Discover the wonders of the kitchen. Techniques and cooking methods will be covered during this week. Your young chef will learn the essential skills to prepare and execute culinary masterpieces - measuring, rolling, making starter dough and baking bread, grating, sautéing, roasting, making a roux. This will be a week of hands on culinary exploration and deliciousness!

Week 3

**Mosaic Madness** - Spend this week learning about working with glass while making amazing works of art. Your child will learn how to cut and handle glass safely. The final project will be a group mosaic that will be hung in the OGMS lobby.
